Volunteer Expectations

Our County and state events are planned, managed and staffed entirely by volunteers. Volunteers are usually Horse project leaders, alumni, members of the horse community, parents, friends and relatives of horse project members.

It is expected that a parent, guardian or other responsible adult associated with each member that is participating will provide support at Horse project events. The intent of this is to set an expectation for volunteer service to the horse project. Leaders should make parents aware of this expectation.

Parent/adult representative participation is expected and is vital to a 4-H member's success. Each member needs an advocate and a support system. Leaders need to have a relationship with member and family. It is difficult to make a project, with the large scope that the Horse Project has, be successful if there is not a Leader/Member/ Parent (adult) connection.
